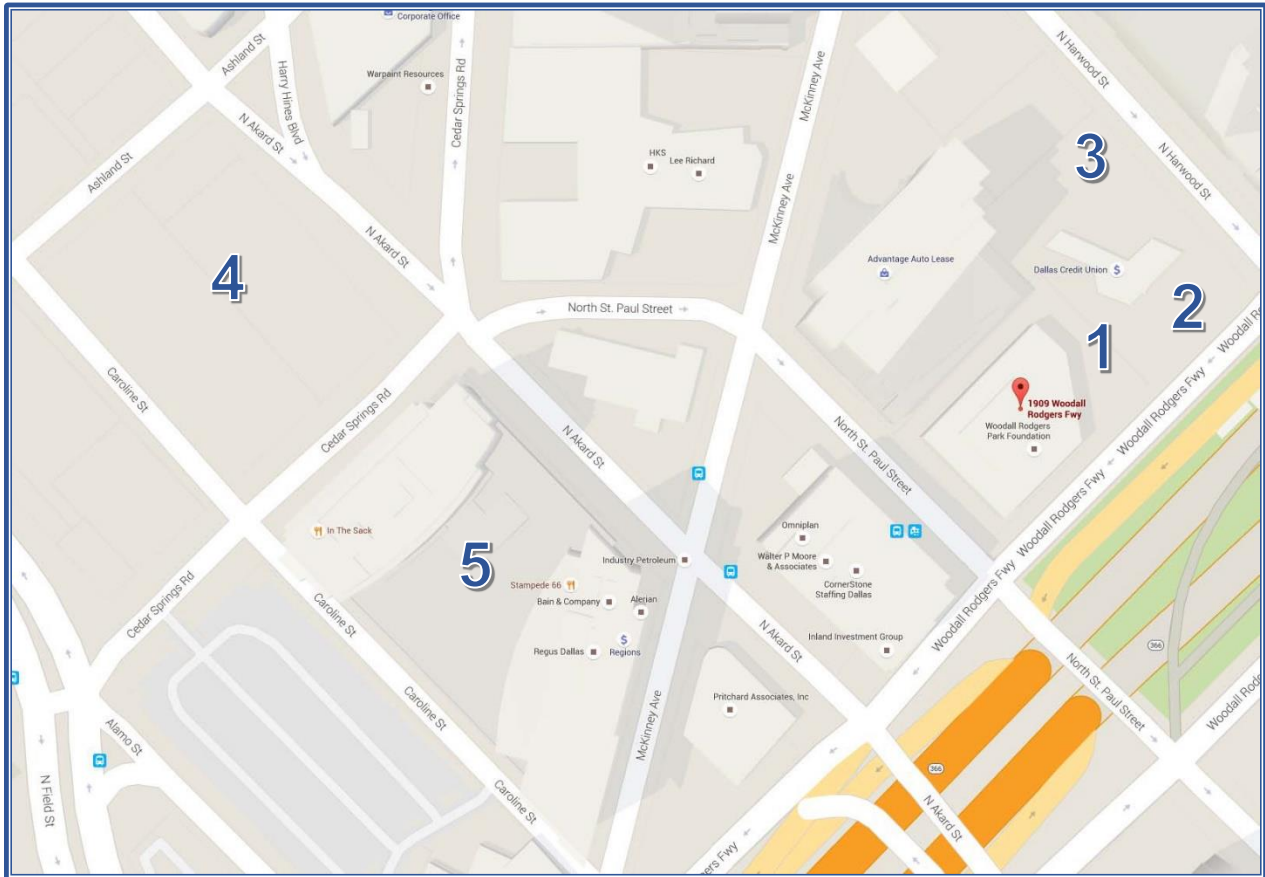


# Parking for events at the Dallas Center for Architecture



The Dallas Center for Architecture is at 1909 Woodall Rodgers Freeway, Suite 100, Dallas, Texas. It is located on the westbound service road of Woodall Rodgers Freeway, between Harwood and St Paul.

## Parking:

- 1) In front of the building, there is limited 2-hour parking (not monitored after 5:00pm). For night-time events, the building's garage will be open after 5:30pm.
- 2) The abandoned building at the corner of Harwood and Woodall Rodgers Parkway has parking spaces in front of and immediately behind the building for a charge.
- 3) At the back of the lot next door, accessible from Harwood Street, are 17 spaces marked "Reserved DCFA". If cones are present, move them to park.
- 4) There is a parking lot in the block between Akard, Cedar Springs, Caroline and Ashland, accessible from North Akard and Ashland. Parking is currently \$5.00
- 5) 17Seventeen McKinney has a parking garage, accessible from Cedar Springs Road and North Akard Street. The public is welcome to park on levels 4 and above. Take a ticket when you enter. The first hour will be free; each additional hour will be \$3.00.
