## Climate Reality Project – Dallas–Fort Worth Chapter

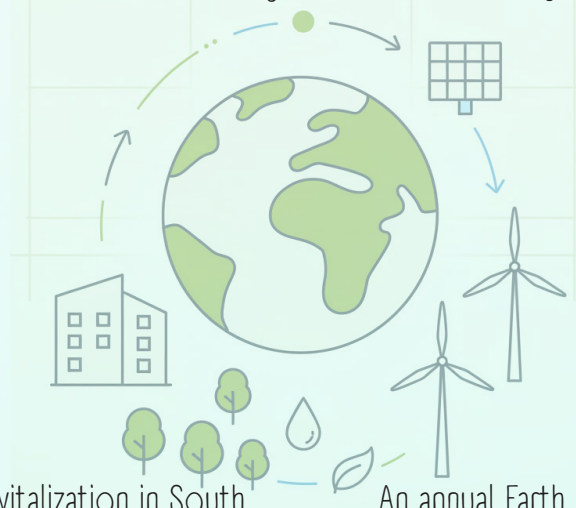
The Climate Reality Project DFW Chapter engages community members through climate education, advocacy, and public programming focused on climate science, resilience, and environmental justice.
